The Trust is looking to recruit a suitable candidate to advance loveLife's income-generation and partnership objectives. The successful applicant would be required to fulfil the following primary functions in a professional manner and with technical excellence:

- Implement loveLife's Youth Health programmes with 10 to 24-year-old youth at health facilities, Y-Centres and/or schools in the community.
- Mobilise young people to access healthcare services across health facilities.
- Map services in the community for youth and refer them to relevant services when or if required.
- Recruit, train, support, and mentor volunteers known as health champions.
- Drive event coordination for all Youth Health and Sports events.
- Conduct all Results Based Monitoring activities using the prescribed tools, processes and systems.
- Provide data collection support for all appropriate loveLife research initiatives.
- Be committed to personal development and growth.
- Manage program resources.
- Report to loveLife's programs coordinator all the implementations and planning.
- Implement Youth Health programmes (Modular Programmes in schools, BFDs, Youth Festivals, Campaigns, etc.).
- Implement the Youth Zones and Youth Clubs across health facilities.
- Market and promote the B.Wise health digital platform for young people's use
- Recruit and Coach team champions.
